Our mission is to create programs for older adults and people with disabilities, empowering and enriching their lives and communities.

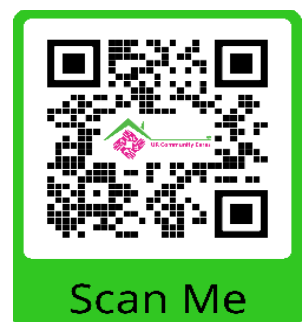
VOLUNTEER WITH US IN ONE OR MORE OF THESE PROGRAMS:
